### LOCATION:



### SUMMARY OF REVELATION LIFE:

Revelation Life began in March 2009 when Simon and Nicola Neal felt a call from God to move with their family to Uganda and start a ministry there. It became clear that the call of Revelation Life was to love and support the poorest of the poor in the local slum communities. The work started in one small community with three full time workers. We are now working in another five much larger communities and our full time team continues to grow. We have just seen a new mission base open in the east end of London and are hoping to expand further into other cities around the world. We have a vision to see whole nations transformed through the love and power of Jesus!

Relationship is key to Revelation Life. Our intention is to build strong relationships as a team and in the communities, bringing hope through the practical and life-changing love of Jesus. We want to see whole communities empowered and transformed in this way, so we maintain this approach through the various projects that we run.

We appreciate your willingness to volunteer with Revelation Life. We hope your year will be a time of growth; personally, spiritually and in line with your skill base.



## INTERN ROLE:

This is an opportunity to gain skills and experience in the operations of a not-for-profit organisation. You will be given tasks that meet the needs of the charity, we will draw on your existing skill base and strengths and we will also encourage you to develop in other areas. We want this to be a safe environment where you can be stretched and grow in your skills and character.



Alongside your work with the Revelation Life team, we will also be encouraging you to volunteer some of your personal time to support a local project that works with the poor/ disadvantaged.

We may also connect you with other local internships, for potential cross-programme training and exposure.

- Opportunities to grow in leadership, including attending 'Senior Leadership Team Days' etc.

## OVERSEAS

During your year with us you will have the opportunity to travel to Uganda and visit our Missions Base there for approx 4 – 6 weeks, working alongside our staff, spending time in the slums and visiting our various projects e.g. Family Centre, Dream Centre etc... (You will need to cover the full cost of this trip)

- To spend approximately one hour with the team each morning praying/ worshipping in the small prayer space
- To commit to self studying and research, including reading and reviewing books from the book list we'll give you
- A willingness to learn and try new things


- To prioritise tasks
- Serve in all areas of work : office/events/missions/administration/conferences
- To volunteer at a local charity that serves the poor for a few hours a week
- To travel to some events when requested
- To join the team in prayer walking Tower Hamlets and establishing monthly worship event 'LOVE London'
- To arrange to meet with your mentor once a month
- Communicate role related concerns/needs to your mentor. \*Please note: personal and pastoral needs should be worked through with your home church
- Get the most out of the year, as it will go quickly
